#### **HONDURAS REPORT**

April 2011

Our team members this year were: Danny & Pat Collins, Pat Garmon, Kim Hayes, Dr. Gordon King, Bruce Jessup, Samuel Lowe, Craig Cook, Dale & Gilda Riddle. Dale & Danny also worked with the second team: Tommy Martin, Mike and Scotty Marion and Ron Inman.

Short summary of our work: 3 days of free surgical clinics in Victoria, 2 days of free open medical clinics in Las Vegas and El Portillo way up on the mountains, hired another doctor to help Gordon, paid for extra medicine needed in the mountains, saw 300 or more patients at each location, gave food to around 100 families in remote villages, first team built a church up to the roof line, second team put up gable ends, poured floor and put up cross beams & rafters, Dale and Danny baptized 12 people, fed the church that came to baptizing—poor, hungry people, Bible school with the children, worship services, Bible studies each night, gave out candy, gum, bracelets, necklaces, Wal-Mart bags, brush mirror sets, trunk full of toothbrushes and toothpaste donated by Fairlawn Baptist and Paulette Lowe given at each place we went and to orphanage, dresses and dolls given out. Pat Garmon and Kim Hayes, nurses, gathered an amazing amount of medical and surgical supplies for mission.

This doesn't cover it all but it gives you an idea of what went on. Our thanks to all who gave medical supplies and other items to take in, financial gifts that made this trip possible and for those who prayed. A special thanks to our teams who gave of themselves to serve our Lord and show the love of our Savior Jesus Christ in Honduras.
